Madam,

In connection with the above referred letters, meeting of CSABNETU- 2015 held on 30th May, 2015 has been attended by Smt. Sunita Kerketter, Asstt. Director of Technical Education and Nodal officer of the State of West Bengal excluding IIEST, Shibpur. In the meeting. Chairman CSABNETU- 2015 has requested to submit the eligibility criteria. Feestructure of the Technical courses alongwith availability of hostel facility with fee structure of hostel in respect of courses proposed to allotted by the MHRD ,Govt. of India through CSABNETU- 15 through URL.

In this connection, it may be stated that the relevant information regarding eligibility criteria for the said courses has already been furnished by this office vide NO. 32-Edn(T)/10M-74/09(Pt-I) dt. 11.02.2015. However Elicality Criteria and Fee Structure of the relevant courses and hostel Fees in the relevant University/Insitutes are as follows:

- (i) In Jadavpur University:
 - (a) Eligibility for Engineering and Technology courses other than Architecture (E) -

The candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination in General Stream of West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent examination of a University/Board in regular class mode with a minimum of 60% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics taken together (55% for SC/ST/PWD) candidates) having individual pass marks in each of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English are eligible for admission to the first year Class of the Undergraduate Engg./Tech./Pharmacy courses provided they satisfy the prescribed medical fitness.

(b) Eligibility for Architecture (E) -

A candidate beside satisfying the eligibility criterion as stated above has to qualify NATA examination, conducted by Council of Architecture (COA), India.

Medical fitness: Candidates seeking admission to aforesaid Undergraduate Engg/Tech/Arch/Pharm courses should possess good health and physique with sound mind and should be capable of undergoing N.C.C. Training. They should not have any physical deformity or infirmity and should not be suffering from any disease or illness that might incapacitate him/her in future. Eye-sight standard: (a) should not be color blind for admission to Chemical, Civil, Architecture, Pharmacy, Metallurgy and Printing Engineering; (b) allowable defect - myopia or myopic astigmatism correcting lens not exceeding 8.00. Medical fitness will not be required for Physically Challenged candidates. Eye sight standard may be revised by the University.

The seats allotted by COA can not be exceeded as per the permission letter of Council of Architecture (COA) India. Hence, the number of supernumerary seat (one number) as allotted by MHRD is needed to get approved by the COA.

(c) Annual Fee Structure for 2015-16 session:

Tuition fees - Rs.900/-, Lab. & Work Shop fees - 1500/-, Session Charge - Rs.50/-, Admission fees - 100/-, Registration fees - Rs.25/- Caution deposit - Rs.25/-, Library Deposit - Rs.50/- and Health Card - Rs.10/- and Admission processing fees Rs.500/-.

(d) Hostel Fees:

There is no reservation of seats in the hostel, except SC 22% and ST 6% and PH 3% as on date. They can apply for Hostel Accommodation, based on two criterion - income of their family and the distance of their home from Jadavpur University.

The monthly Seat Rent and Electricity fees of the hostel (for UG and PG Students) is Rs 25/per month and For M Phil and Ph D Scholar Rs. 350/-. The messing (cost of food/meal) as per the monthly charges to be borne by the candidate himself/ herself which generally ranges between

- (ii) In Government College of Engineering and Leather Technology, Kolkata and Jalpaiguri Government Engineering College
 - (a) Eligibility for Engineering and Technology courses:

Candidates must pass 10+2 examination from a recognized council or board with individual pass marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as compulsory subjects and minimum of 45% marks in the above mentioned subjects taken together (40% for SC/ST/OBC/PwD candidates) as well as pass in English with minimum 30% marks.

 - (iii) Mess: Own arrangement done by the students; at present per meal charge is Rs. 25/- (variable) payable to mess committee.
 - (iv) Establishment charge (payable to mess committee, one time, Rs 500/- at the time of entry).
- (d) Hostel Fees in Jalpaiguri Government Engineering College:
 - (i) Mess Entry Fee (One Time) Rs. 300.00
 - (ii) Hostel Development Fund (One Time) Rs. 400.00
 - (iii) Hostel Seatrent (Per Semester) Rs. 300.00
 - (iv) Electricity Charges (Per Semester) Rs.210.00
 - (v) Hostel Caution Money (One Time, Refundable) Rs.2500.00
